## READING

In a small group setting, hands-on activities will improve upon their sight word recognition, decoding skills, expression and fluency, phonological awareness, oral vocabulary, comprehension, sequencing, and much more.

## MATH

Mastery of basic math skills provides an important foundation for your child’s entire academic success. Campers, working on their appropriate grade level, will practice, reinforce, and enrich their knowledge and confidence of math facts and problem-solving skills.

## ARTS and CRAFTS

Research shows arts and crafts assist school age children in the development of their cognitive, emotional, social and sensory-motor goals. Through the use of arts and crafts, each day will offer children a new topic for discussion and a variety of artistic and crafting activities designed to promote imagination, encourage self-expression, spark creativity, and enhance motor coordination.

## STEM

STEM education prepares today’s students in the skills and competencies of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math. It develops critical thinking which promotes the next generation of innovators. Campers will collaborate, design, and create projects in a fun-filled, interactive environment.

Mrs. Gaspich and Mrs. Rybczynski, current first and second grade teachers, have approached learning by utilizing creative and fun methods for over forty years of combined teaching experience. They also have wide-ranging experience in private and group tutoring for children grades K - 5.

The classes will take place over a two week period, consisting of eight days, in an air-conditioned room. The first week will take place on June 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup>, and 20<sup>th</sup>. The second week will take place on June 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, and 27<sup>th</sup>. Class time is 9:00am - 11:30am.

The cost for each week is \$160 (supplies and registration fee included!)
